Hillcrest's Board of Directors wants to keep members informed as we transition from the long tenure of our current PGA Professional to a new Head Golf Professional who will begin work in January 2019. Additionally, we will discuss other items of interest to the members.

Recent Items of Interest:

- A party for John and Debbie will be held after the Club Championship on Sunday, August 19th starting at 1:00 p.m. in the club house. Drinks and snacks will be provided. Come and wish them good luck in their new adventure in Idaho.
- The Pro Shop will be open until 5:00 p.m. for merchandise sales on August 20. Tee times, cart rental, and range use will continue as always.
- **Great News!!!** We will have NEW range balls on Tuesday, August 21st. If you have any old range balls, please turn them in to the Pro Shop by Monday, August 20th.
- The Grounds crew will be aerating the greens Tuesday, September 11th and Wednesday, September 12th.
- On-site interviews for a new Golf Professional will begin on August 27th. Each candidate will arrive at different days of the week to spend two days with us. The first day will have them play a round of golf and acclimate to the area. Throughout the second day, the candidate will meet with three different interview teams, each asking questions about a specific area of the Golf Pro's responsibilities. The interview teams will be made up of nine board members, three Club members, and four employees. **At the end of each interview day, an Open House will be held for members to meet the candidate in which the candidate will make a presentation and there will be an opportunity for the members to ask questions. This is your chance to participate and meet the candidates.**

After all the interviews, the interview team members will share their scoring of the interviews and discuss their thoughts about which candidate would be the best fit for the Club. The Board of Directors will make the final decision, and then make an offer employment to the candidate following the September Regular meeting.

- All credits earned during the 2018 season may be used prior to John Vickers' departure, and we encourage credit holders to do so. However, if not redeemed, those credits will be honored through the 2019 season until Dec. 31.
- Also remember that this year's Board of Director elections will be electronic, so please update your email address with the Club Office prior to the November election.
