Last December, the Board of Directors authorized an update of the course's 2013 Master Plan to reflect course renovations made in 2015. Since repairs to our cart paths are being considered in the future, the update would also highlight where some cart paths may be eliminated and therefore repairs in those areas would not be needed. This updated plan is now ready for review. Our golf course architect, Kevin Norby, will present the updated plan including its history and the progress the club has made in accomplishing its recommendations. His presentation will begin immediately after the March Board meeting at 6:30 in the clubhouse. There will be plenty of time following his remarks for questions from the audience.
