I. PURPOSE

- A. As stated in the Hillcrest Bylaws, Section 5.2(c), the Board of Directors shall have the power and authority to make the rules of conduct for the Members of the Corporation and for the use of the Corporation's property.
- B. This policy is not intended to restrict the rights of anyone but rather to ensure that members, guests, and staff can expect to be treated politely and with respect while at Hillcrest.

II. CODE OF CONDUCT

- A. All members and guests will:
 - 1. Conduct themselves in a responsible and sportsmanlike manner.
 - 2. Respect the rights of other players and golf course staff.
 - 3. Not consume alcoholic beverages to the point of impairment or intoxication. Hillcrest reserves the right to refuse service to any person under impairment.
 - 4. Not bring in alcoholic beverages to Hillcrest.
 - 5. Not engage in any form of sexual, racial, or religious discrimination or harassment.
 - 6. Adhere to the Hillcrest dress code and observe proper golf etiquette as per the USGA and local rules of the course.
 - 7. Respect the golf course, golf carts, and facilities.
 - 8. Adhere to all club rules and the Hillcrest Golf Club Policies.
 - 9. Abide by all state and local laws and regulations, including not being in possession of illegal drugs and/or weapons on Hillcrest property.

III. RESOLUTION OF VIOLATIONS

- A. Should a violation take place, it will be put on the agenda for the next Board of Directors meeting. A special meeting of the Board of Directors may also be called. Notice of the meeting will be sent via email to the members.
- B. In all cases where there is damage to property, monetary restitution is mandatory.
- C. After discussion, the Board of Directors shall offer the golfer an opportunity to state their case. The Board will determine the extent of the disciplinary action, which could include temporary or complete loss of membership or playing privileges.
