Event Formats

Morning (18 Hole) Partner Matches

Front 9 (Holes 1-9) 2-Person Best Ball (*Play your own ball/Best score*)

90% Handicap – Dotted/Stroked off Low Handicap – Net Only

Back 9 (Holes 10-18) 2-Person Traditional Alternate Shot (Foursomes)

60% Low Handicap & 40% High Handicap – True Alternate Shot – Net Only

(Choose which player tees off first hole of Alternate Shot & keep rotation throughout the entire 9 Holes)

DO NOT Pick Odd/Even Holes for Tee Shots

Afternoon (9 Hole) Individual Matches

9 Hole – Individual NET Match Play (Paired but not partnered with teammate)

100% Handicap – Dotted/Stroked off Low Handicap – Traditional Match Play

Net Only

Hole-by-Hole Points: Earn points per hole for all 27 holes of play (ALL Formats)

(Each hole is worth 1 available point)

For Example: If Player (A) makes a Par on a hole and his/her opponent, Player (B), makes a Bogey, Player (A) would receive 1 point for their team on that hole. If Player (A) & (B) both make Par (tie) on the hole, each Player would receive ½ point for their team on that hole.

A total of 27 points are available for each Player/Pairs throughout the entire day.

Please record GROSS Scores for each Player/Pair on the scorecard

Tournament Committee Members/Captains will award the Hole-by-Hole Points to ensure accuracy

****Holes may be conceded if a Player/Pair are “out of the hole” to ensure quality Pace of Play****

Tee Selections

Player Tee Selections will be based off the Majority of Scores posted to Individual GHIN USGA Accounts.

Please double check your Tee Selection with your Team Captain prior to play

Morning Shotgun Scorecards will be provided by Team Captain at Registration

Afternoon Individual Match Play Pairings will be paired by Morning Team Results

1st & 2nd Place Teams will play against each other / Matches paired by Handicap Indexes

3rd & 4th Place Teams will play against each other / Matches paired by Handicap Indexes

Each team has a chance to win money (even 4th Place), if they have a strong showing in the afternoon!

1st & 2nd Place Teams will win Prize Money after the completion of the Afternoon Individual Matches!

GENERAL AND LOCAL RULES:

1. USGA Rules will apply. Rules on score card as well as the following local rules will apply.
2. **Time of Starting:** Player late for starting time but within 5 minutes of tee time will be given a two-stroke penalty. After 5 minutes, player will be disqualified.
3. Play affected by weather conditions will be ruled on by the Rules Committee.
DISCONTINUE PLAY IMMEDIATELY: 1 LONG TONE of siren
RESUME PLAY: 1 CONTINUOUS HIGH-LOW TONE of siren
(2 Stroke penalty for violation of the above.)
4. **Out-Of-Bounds:** All boundary fences and white stakes bounding the course. White stakes to the right of Holes #1, 13, 15, 17, and behind Holes #6 and #12. Driving Range Fence on #'s 8 & 9 is out of bounds.
HILLCREST DOES NOT CURRENTLY OBSERVE ANY LOCAL RULES THAT PLAY OUT OF BOUNDS AS A "LATERAL PENALTY AREA". Out of Bounds is Stroke and Distance.
5. All artificially surfaced cart paths will be considered immovable obstructions with nearest relief taken – no closer to the hole – unless taking that relief is to obtain relief from a boundary/out of bounds fence.
6. **Ground Under Repair** is any area encircled by white paint.
7. **Embedded Ball:** In the 'General Area' a ball embedded in its own pitch mark may be lifted, cleaned and dropped, without penalty, as near as possible to where it lay but not nearer the hole.
8. If the ball comes to rest in any of the following places, it can be dropped without penalty not nearer the hole and within 1 club length of the point of nearest relief:
 - A. Gravel drainage ditch.
 - B. In a rodent hole or obvious spill from a rodent hole.
 - C. Where stance or swing are impeded by a "staked" tree.
9. **Undue Delay; Slow Play:** A player shall be subject to penalty if he/she unduly delays play. A group is out of position when there is an open hole ahead, or when it has not yet begun a par 5, and the group ahead is on the green. Groups out of position are expected to play faster, catch up, and regain its proper position during the next two holes.
10. **Rules and Decisions:** If in doubt about a rule, play a second ball, hole out with both balls. You must report the facts of the situation to the Rules Committee before returning your scorecard. Failure to do so, will result in disqualification.
11. Conforming clubs and balls of the USGA must be used.
12. **Cellular Phones:** Use of cellular phones, outside of being used as a Measuring Device, is not permitted on the competition course, unless there is an emergency. Do not call for a ruling. Breach of Rule: 1st Offense 2 Stroke Penalty 2nd Offense Disqualification.
13. **Electronic Measuring Devices:** The use of any USGA approved measuring device is Permitted.
14. **Conduct:** Unbecoming conduct by a player, reported to the Committee before, during, or after a competitor's round, may be cause of disqualification or action under Rule 33-7. Unbecoming conduct includes, but is not limited to: foul language, club throwing, abuse of the golf course or course property, abuse of officials, or any conduct unbecoming of a gentleman. Players may also be suspended from playing in future events.
15. **Golf balls must be played "down" throughout all Match Play Formats.**
16. **The "One Ball Rule" is not in affect. Golf balls can not be switched during the play of a hole. Announce any golf ball changes.**
17. Each player must check her/his own score as the player is responsible for the correct gross score on each hole.
18. The competitor and marker must sign the scorecard.
